Thank you for your support with our new King Henry VIII 3-19 School uniform. Our uniform is an important part of our identity and provides community and cohesion within the school. It supports positive behaviour, ensures pupils are dressed appropriately for learning activity, and supports and promotes the ethos of the school.

Please note that all secondary section pupils are required to wear the school blazer. Iron on/sew on badges continue to be available free of charge from the school and there is no requirement to buy branded items.

All pupils were provided with a school tie, free of charge. Please contact us if you need to collect your school tie.

Pupils can wear school skirt or school trousers. These must be smart and black. Beyond this, there is no specific style required. Skirts must be knee length for health and safety reasons, as explained in our Uniform Policy. This allows pupils to take part in all school activities, including practical activities, safely.

The school uniform for secondary section pupils is as follows:

- Black blazer
- White long or short sleeved shirt or white blouse with collar
- King Henry VIII 3-19 School tie
- Bottle Green V-Neck school jumper (optional)
- Smart black school skirt, trousers, or shorts
- Plain black socks or tights
- Plain black school shoes (leather or leather look)
