St David's Day

- Complete assigned questions on Sparx Maths.
- Complete guestions on Educake (released at various points of the half-term).
- Learn Welsh vocabulary (provided by the class teacher once a fortnight).

- Read for pleasure (15 minutes every day).

Year 11 and Year 13 pupils will attend all normal lessons until Friday 24th May. There will be times when pupils have examinations during the school day and breaks will be provided before and after. If pupils have a lesson where examinations have finished, pupils will revise in those



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lessons for other subjects. Normal attendance procedures apply if your child is absent in this period.

From Monday 3rd June, Year 11 and Year 13 pupils will only attend lessons in subjects where the examinations are not complete. Full attendance is required in these lessons. Pupils completing BTEC courses should attend all lessons until the teachers informs them that all requirements of the coursework have been completed. Any requests to study at home, which might be applicable towards the end of the examination period, must be authorised by the school before commencement.

It is important that pupils remain available throughout the examination period, all the way to Wednesday 26th June. This is because contingency dates are used should examinations not be able to go ahead on publicised dates.

There is the opportunity for Year 11 pupils to complete private study in the Senior Phase Resource Area from 3.00pm to 4.00pm on Mondays-Thursdays. This is supervised provision with access to IT facilities.
