# Times Tables Rock Stars and Study Ladder (Primary Phase – Home-learning)

All pupils in Years 1-6 should complete 20 minutes per week at home on <u>Times Tables Rock Stars</u>. This is an online programme that allows pupils to learn and consolidate their times tables, as well as boosting fluency in multiplication and division. All pupils in Years 3-6 should also complete the assigned weekly literacy tasks on <u>Study Ladder</u> each week at home. This is an online programme that allow pupils to consolidate their learning about new vocabulary, helps develop their skills to extract and construct meaning from text, and helps develops their spelling, reading, and grammar skills.

#### Home-learning (Years 7, 8, and 9)

Please see below a summary of the weekly home-learning requirements for Years 7, 8, and 9.

- Complete activities on <u>Vocabulous</u> (a new root word is released every fortnight for Year 7 and every week for Years 8 and 9).
