Pupil Learning Agreement

The Pupil Learning Agreement is intended to give pupils a clear understanding of what they can expect from the Sixth Form and what will be expected of them in return.

Under this agreement King Henry VIII 3-19 Sixth Form will endeavour to provide:

- A programme of courses that is delivered by qualified and effective members of staff using appropriate facilities and resources.
- A friendly, caring and supportive environment.
- An academic mentor, who monitors your progress, provides guidance and assurance in setting targets for improvement.
- The provision of structured guidance for the use of private study time, including the regular setting and marking of formal work to be tackled during private study time, in a place set aside by the school.
- Support in developing good study skills and coping with stress.
- Support for any recognised special needs you may have.
- The opportunity to take part in enrichment and extra curricular activities, e.g. The Seren Network, Youth Speaks, PALS etc.
- A careers programme suited to your needs with easy access to expert careers advice.
- Opportunities each year for your parents to discuss your progress.
- One set of written reports each year and a half-termly continuous assessment report.



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- Opportunities for flexible use of non-contact time for those pupils who meet all our expectations of a Sixth Form pupils.

In return, you will be expected to:

- Be determined to make the most of your time in the Sixth Form.
- Accept responsibility for your own learning with support of your academic mentor and subject teachers.
- Participate in regular reviews of progress being made with targets being set.
- Understand that you will be expected to do a great deal of your Sixth Form work outside of school hours.
- Complete all work to the required standard by the required deadline.
- Use your private study time in school effectively.
- Attend all lessons punctually. As a full time pupils you will be expected to be in school for all your lessons between 9:00 am to 3.00 pm and to attend any academic mentor appointments and assemblies at 8:40 am
- Inform your academic mentor in advance if you need to be away from school for any good reason and fill in an appropriate form, which must be returned to the Sixth Form Office for authorisation.
- Inform subject teachers in advance if you have to miss their lesson for any reason.
- Sign in or out, as appropriate, at all times.
- Act as a positive role model for the younger pupils in the school.
- Respect the individual rights of all members of the school community and behave according to the whole school code of conduct.



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- Contribute to the life of King Henry VIII 3-19 School through enrichment activities and by taking on responsibilities.
- Use the lower car-park if you need to park a car.
- To attend all work experience placements as required for any BTEC courses you may study.
- Wear your Pupil ID at all times when on site.
- Accept that you may be asked to leave King Henry VIII 3-19 School if the above conditions are not met.
