A successful school experience requires a great partnership between families, pupils, and the school. Our Home School Agreement helps us work together by defining some of our responsibilities. It helps us achieve our vision for all pupils to make rapid progress and achieve academic excellence in an environment of love and care. The agreement is based on our unwavering belief in the limitless capacity for everyone to achieve great things.

## Pupils

To help me do well at school, I will:

1. Respect the rights of everyone at school to learn and be safe
2. Put lots of effort into my learning
3. Follow all instructions in my lessons and at school
4. Listen to the teacher and other pupils when asked
5. Complete my home learning
6. Use only positive and friendly language
7. Be polite to all staff and pupils
8. Walk calmly around the school
9. Come to school every day on time
10. Attend all lessons on time
11. Wear the correct school uniform and P.E. kit
12. Bring the correct equipment to school
13. Eat only healthy items in school
14. Make sure my smart phone is left at home - or handed to my teacher/kept in my bag (dependent on school policy for the age of the child) if it is essential that I bring this to school).
15. Follow all health and safety procedures
16. Follow the guidelines for school trips, visits, and activities
17. Behave in a responsible manner during my journeys to and from school
18. Use technology safely and respectfully
19. Embrace the values of the school
20. Talk at home about my learning
21. Talk to my teacher or another grown up at school about any worries I have

## Parents

To help my child at school, I will:

1. Help my child understand and respect everyone's rights to learn, be safe, and feel safe
2. Make sure my child attends school and comes on time each day
3. Encourage my child to put in lots of effort
4. Listen to my child read
5. Help my child complete their home learning
6. Talk to my child about their learning
7. Support pupil involvement in extra-curricular activity
8. Ensure that my child wears full school uniform
9. Ensure my child brings a full P.E. kit
10. Ensure my child brings all the required equipment
11. Work with the school to ensure my child behaves well and get in touch if there are any problems at home that may affect my child's learning or behaviour.

12. Support the school with the implementation of the behaviour policy
13. Ensure my child only brings healthy food and drink items into school
14. Ensure my child leaves their smart phone at home - or remind them that it must be kept in their bag/handed to their teacher (dependent on school policy for the age of the child) if it is essential that they bring this to school
15. Help ensure my child follows all health and safety procedures
16. Ensure my child follows the technology usage agreement
17. Arrange leave during school holidays and medical appointments outside of the school day
18. Behave appropriately; respecting staff, parents and children at all times on school grounds
19. Use only positive and friendly language whilst at school
20. Contact the school as soon as possible if my child is absent
21. Attend parents' evenings and events for parents
22. Reply to any school correspondence
23. Avoid any debts in my payments to the school

## School

The school will do its best to:

1. Provide a stimulating and challenging learning environment, with high quality teaching
2. Make sure your child learns well
3. Provide pupils with regular feedback, including their next steps for learning
4. Respect everyone's rights
5. Ensure there are robust procedures for the reporting and tackling of any bullying, recognizing the absolute right of pupils to attend school without fear of bullying behaviour from others
6. Maintain and promote a caring environment and ethos, based on our positive shared values
7. Contact parents and carers as soon as possible, if we are concerned about your child's well-being, learning or behaviour
8. Get back to you as soon as possible if you write to us or phone us
9. Welcome parents and carers into the life of the school and keep you informed about general school matters
10. Let you know regularly how your child is progressing with written reports and meetings
11. Set your child regular home learning activities, including reading
12. Offer a broad and balanced curriculum which meets the needs of your child
13. Provide a range of extra-curricular activities designed to enrich and extend children's school experience
14. Celebrate pupils' efforts, successes, and achievements
