

School Trips

Parental permission is required for any trip that involves public transport (for example, trains and buses) and which takes place out of normal school hours. You will be contacted in advance of any such trip.

Permission for routine trips that take place within usual school hours is gained on this admission form. Parents and carers are not asked to provide permission for their child to attend prior to each of these trips. This includes trips where pupils walk to the venue (in the local area) and where pupils travel on coaches.

Permission for routine off-site visits
I agree to my child participating in routine visits off the school site. These visits might include the following, or similar, activities: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Sporting fixtures.• Sponsored walks.• Places of scientific or geographical interest.• Theatres.• Visits to cultural sites and museums.• Meetings on behalf of the school council.
These visits will usually take place at the following, or similar, locations: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Other school sites and sporting venues such as Cwmbran Stadium.• A planned walk around the local area including into Abergavenny using a variety of footpaths in the town and including the canal.• Cultural visits to places such as Chepstow Castle, Cardiff Museum, Big Pit, Oxford University, Harry Potter Studios, St Fagans Museum of Welsh Life.• Places of scientific or geographical interest such as Castle Meadows or the Deri.• Theatre visits to places such as the Borough Theatre, New Theatre in Cardiff or Stratford upon Avon.• Meetings in places such as County Hall or other schools.
I understand that: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Such visits will usually take place within normal school/establishment hours, but that if they are likely to extend beyond this, adequate advance notice will be given so that I may make appropriate arrangements for my child's return home.• My specific permission will be sought for any visits involving public transport and which could involve commitment to extended journeys, times or expense.• All reasonable care will be taken of my child during the visit.• My child will be under obligation to obey directions given, and to observe all rules and regulations governing the visit, and will be subject to usual school behaviour procedures during the visit.• I must inform the school of any medical/behavioural condition or physical disabilities that may affect my child or others during the visit.• All young people are covered by the Local Authority's (LA) third party public liability insurance in respect of any claim arising from an accident caused by a defect in the school premises or equipment or attributable to negligence by the Council or one of its employees. The LA also provides personal injury and travel insurance for all participants whilst taking part in organised visits outside the designated school boundaries.
