The Abergavenny Education Foundation of King Henry VIII

We would like to take this opportunity to wish you every success in your future endeavours and to remind you of your eligibility to apply for the Foundation Governor Awards. These awards are for everyone to apply for as long as you have been at King Henry VIII 3-19 School for at least 2 years. Previous applications have requested help with a range of different aspects of further study from computer equipment to uniform required for a course. Typically, awards are between £150-£200 per award and you can apply for the award a maximum of three times, with no more than one per year.

King Henry VIII Boys' Grammar School in Pen-y-Pound was originally established through public subscription from Abergavenny and the surrounding area. When the school was sold to Monmouthshire County Council in 1964, the proceeds were invested in the Charities Official Investment Fund. The income generated from this fund is distributed twice yearly by the Governors of the Educational Foundation of King Henry VIII.

Under the approved scheme, Governors have wide discretion in awarding grants to support educational advancement beyond what is typically provided by the Local Education Authority. This includes:

- Support for further education leading to an accredited qualification
- Travel grants and scholarships
- Assistance with the study of music and the arts leading to an accredited qualification
- Support for sporting and cultural activities leading to an accredited qualification

Eligibility Criteria:

- Applicants must be under 25 years of age
- Applicants must have attended King Henry VIII School for at least two years
- A maximum of three applications may be submitted, with no more than one per year
- There is no means test
